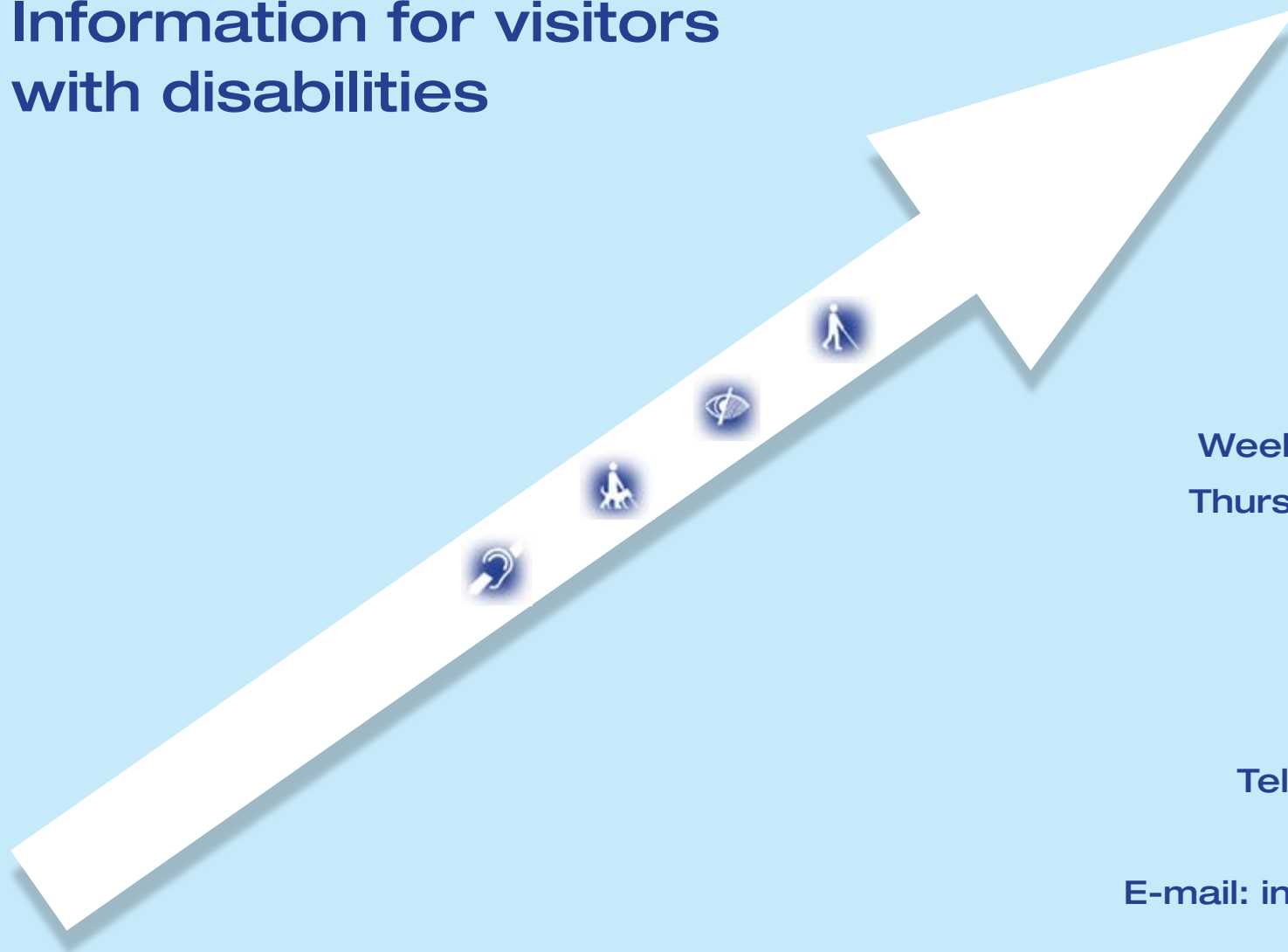

For visually impaired visitors to the Museum

We have professional staff on hand to conduct individual and group guided tours every weekday from 10 to 17h.

Visitors can freely move through the Museum with the help of the Braille guide or with the guidance of our staff.

All legends and texts are in large print and in Braille.

Audio guides for visitors are also available at the information counter.

All displayed objects or their replicas can be experienced by touch.

A tactile session can be arranged in our storeroom for items not on display in the permanent exhibition display area.



For hearing impaired visitors to the Museum

Every Wednesday we organize sign language group tours through the exhibition area.

For mobility impaired visitors to the Museum

The Museum's exhibition area and storeroom are accessible for wheelchair users.

The Museum is located on the 2nd floor of the building and is accessible by elevator.

The Museum building is equipped with an elevator.

The Museum is located in Parking Zone I. There is a handicapped parking space on Šenoina Street.

- Trams no. 2, 4, 6, 9 or 13 from the west,
- Trams no. 4, 8, 9 or 13 from the north,
- Trams no. 2, 6 or 8 from the east.
